Session Overview

S - STRENGTHS

Students discover their personal strengths using the Strengths Explorer© on-line analysis. We discuss how to capitalize on personal strengths in teamwork and individual academic and social success.

C - CHARACTER

Students explore personal values as the foundation of character and wise decision making . A special emphasis is given to three core values of wisdom, integrity and courage in living an authentic life.

R & E - REVIEW & EDUCATIONALLY MANAGE MEDIA AND TECHNOLOGY

Students learn to use wisdom and integrity during interactions on social media and other online platforms. Their critical thinking skills are engaged through analyzing media messages, and discovering how to find trustworthy information online.

A - AUTHENTIC ALLIANCES

Students are given the tools to create healthy relationships that promote success in shared community spaces, such as school, sports and home.

M - MY LIFE IS MY INFLUENCE

Students learn that the willingness to give of themselves and their time can make a meaningful difference in the life of another. We discuss how such courageous & heroic living is available to each of us, and how our lives can create lasting impact.
